A NEW FEATURE TO BE PRESENTED

MOLD VARIATIONS

It has been a painstaking, and often frustrating, endeavor but we now have some excellent sketches ready to share with you, our members.

These mold variations will serve to make the avid collector aware of often overlooked details. This information will make very clear why we collect figurines from different countries and manufacturers. Country markings, paint dots, manufacturer's names, etc., are all **"RED flags"** alerting us to the possibility of important variations.

This new, regular feature, will begin in Newsletter 29, Spring 1993, our **EIGHTH YEAR!!!!**

" UNION JACK SMURF "

Our British friends have nick-named this Smurf figurine "Union Jack," the name sometimes used for the National Flag of Great Britain. Officially, the flag emblem is the British Union Flag.

The figurine used is #20030 Torchbearer. It is not the "Olympic Smurf" mold described in Newsletter Eleven, Winter 1988.



The emblem is red, white, and blue. The red shorts are a darker red than the #20030 Torchbearer. The figure is West German and painted in Portugal.

*Special Note: In Newsletter IV, Spring 1987, we mentioned that we had reason to suspect that the #20030 Torchbearer was produced with different country emblems. Since that time, only this variation has been verified.

BUYER BEWARE

We have been advised that there is a flood of Smurf Cels being sold on the market. The bad news about this is that they bear **FAKE AUTOGRAPHS!** Yes, the autographs are forgeries. However, the cels are authentic. These cels were **NOT** autographed by Hanna Barbera and their release was not authorized by their studio.

Below is an advertisement for one of these cels. The Ad is also deceptive, as Smurf Cels are not from the 1970's!

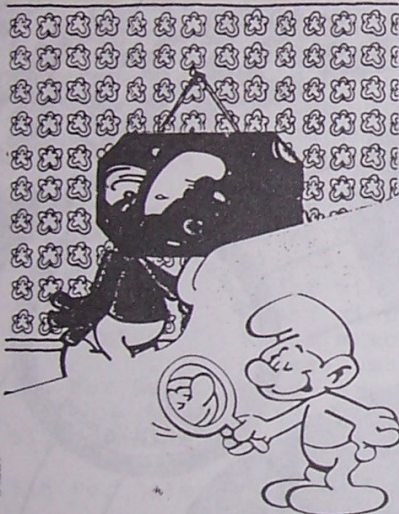

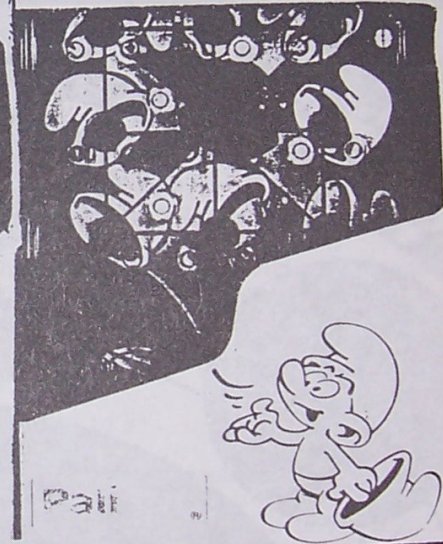

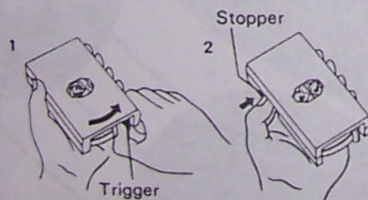

Delivery wheel

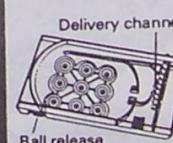

First, ensure all the balls are in the delivery channel, then move each in turn to the first club by rotating the delivery wheel in the direction shown (illustration a). Then carefully try to flick one ball at a time from club to club to the 18th hole. If you fail, the ball will land in the rough and will not count towards your score. One point is scored for each ball in the 18th hole (illustration b).

POCKETEERS SMURF HAT & TRICK

Put the Smurfs into a row



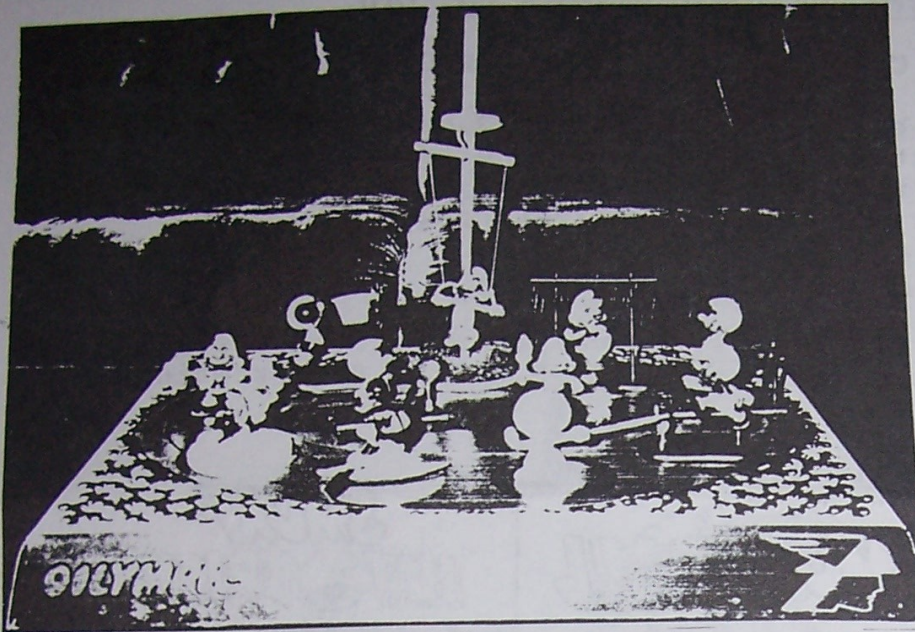
Ensure that all nine balls are in the delivery channel before pulling back the trigger and firing at the hats (see diagram). Points are scored only when you get three balls into a row — either diagonally, vertically or horizontally (see diagram). A ball may count towards more than one row at a time. For each complete row of three, score the following:

- 1 row — 5 points
- 2 rows — 10 points
- 3 rows — 15 points
- 4 rows — 20 points
- 5 rows — 25 points
- 6 rows — 30 points

For a full grid of all nine balls, score 50 points.

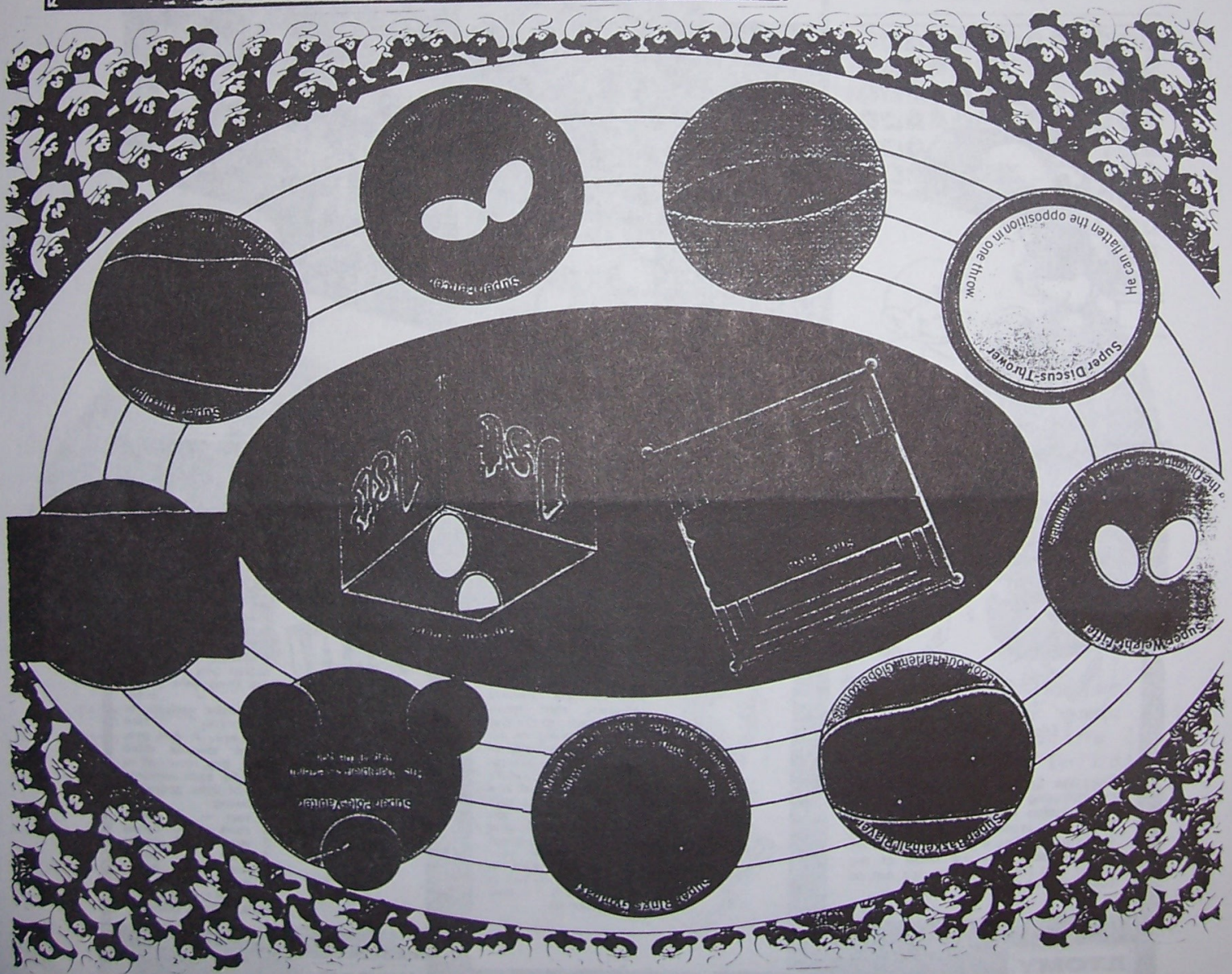
